IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for PWS 0400302

Our water system violated drinking water requirements recently. Even though this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing (did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for coliform bacteria on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During August 2021 we did not monitor for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for recently, how often we are supposed to sample for coliform bacteria, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.
